



5-HT₃


Ondansetron

Dose: 0.1mg/kg (4-8mg), 8°



Synthetic Carbazole
Blocks vagal afferents from GI tract
Central action at CTZ


Constipation ↓ HR Headache & Flushing


Cyclizine

Dose: 1mg/kg (25-50mg), 8°



Piperazine derivative
Reduces sensitivity of vestibular apparatus
Also has anticholinergic properties


↑ LOS tone | Dry mouth ↑ HR Drowsiness Blurred vision


Prochlorperazine

Dose: IM 12.5mg, 12°




Phenothiazine neuroleptic
Central action at CTZ

VTE, | ↑ QT_c NMS | Parkinsonism | Lower seizure threshold Dry mouth



Dexamethasone

Dose: 0.1mg/kg (4-8mg)



Glucocorticoid
Unclear mechanism for antiemetic effects
